Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to be a member of the Long Beach Yacht Club? All interested sailors are welcome to attend camp. The nonmember fee includes a Junior Membership for insurance purposes.

What are the prices for each two-week session? \$450 for members and \$500 for non-members

How early should I register my child for camp? Sign up as soon as possible to ensure you child's spot in the session. Registration is available at LongBeachYachtClub.com.

Is owning your own sailboat a requirement to attend sail camp? You do not have to own your own boat to attend camp. LBYC will be using 420s, Lasers, Optimists, and Flying Scots to teach your child how to sail.

What should my child bring to camp? Your sailor should bring a lifejacket that fits, sunscreen, closed toe water shoes, towel, change of clothes, sunglasses, bathing suit and a bag to keep their belongings organized.

What will my child learn throughout LBYC's sail camp? First time sailors will learn the parts of the boat, sails, rigging, and basic knots. Sailors with more experience will be focusing more on the basic fundamentals of a lifelong sport. Sportsmanship, boat handling, and boat speed will be emphasized in particular. Above all, LBYC's hope is that your child will be able to learn a lifelong skill and have fun doing it!
