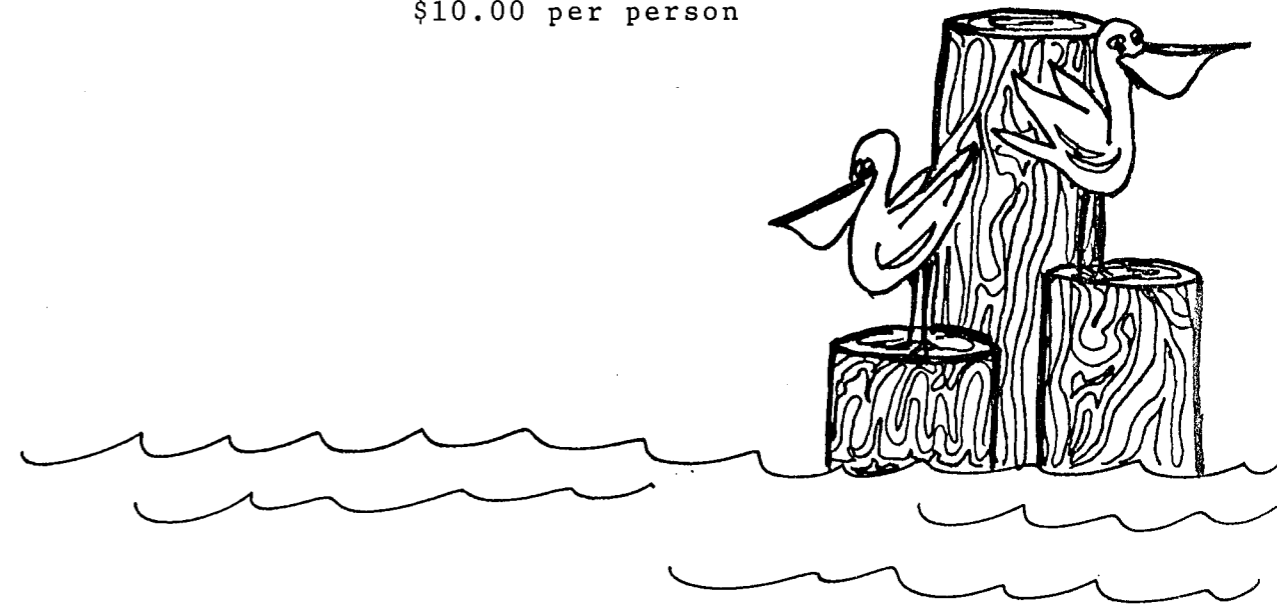

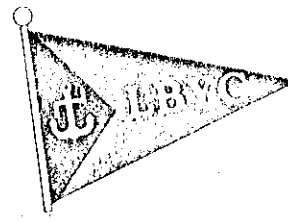

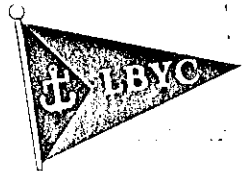
Your vote will be required on several matters of importance including the election of Flag Officers for 1983 and the election of four Governing Board members who will serve two-year terms.

NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS--THE FOLLOWING IS EXTRACTED FROM THE BYLAWS OF OUR ORGANIZATION:

The Governing Board shall be responsible to appoint and approve at the appropriate time under these Bylaws a Nominating Committee composed of seven resident members in good standing for purposes of placing in nomination a ticket to be submitted at the General Membership Meeting for the election of the Flag Officers and eight members of the Governing Board. Five members of the Nominating Committee shall constitute a quorum.

Not less than thirty days prior to the Annual General Membership Meeting, the Governing Board shall appoint a Nominating Committee to serve, said committee shall nominate a ticket to be submitted at the General Membership Meeting for the election of Flag Officers and two(2) year term members of the Board, and vacancies of the one (1) year remaining members of the Board. The ticket as selected by the Nominating Committee shall be posted in the Club house and a copy thereof mailed with the notice of the Annual General Membership Meeting to all voting members of the club by the Secretary no less than twenty (20) days prior to the date of the Annual Membership Meeting.

NOMINATIONS OF ALTERNATE TICKETS

ANY SEVEN MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING MAY AGREE TO PLACE IN NOMINATION ANY OTHER TICKET, OR TICKETS. IF MORE THAN ONE IS PROPERLY PLACED IN NOMINATION, IT SHALL BE POSTED IN THE CLUB HOUSE NOT LESS THAN TEN (10) DAYS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING, AND SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE SECRETARY IN SUFFICIENT TIME FOR THE SECRETARY TO MAIL COPIES OF SAID TICKET OR TICKETS TO ALL VOTING MEMBERS OF THE CLUB NOT LESS THAN TEN (10) DAYS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING.

NO NOMINATIONS SHALL BE CONSIDERED IN THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING EXCEPT AS MADE IN THE MANNER PROVIDED HEREIN.

To be elected at the Annual Membership Meeting, each elected Flag Officer and member of the Governing Board must receive a majority of the ballots cast. Where alternate tickets are submitted voting shall be by secret ballot. Also, where alternate tickets are submitted, a voting member may cast one vote for one nominee for each Flag Officer position, and shall not be required to vote for all nominees as there are Board Member positions to be filled, and may vote for anyone duly nominated as a Board Member without being required to vote for all nominees of a same ticket. Those nominated for election to the four (4) two-year term positions to the Governing Board receiving the highest total number of votes shall be elected; and in the same manner for those nominated to fill vacancies in the positions having one-year unexpired terms remaining.

NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS--THE FOLLOWING IS EXTRACTED FROM THE BYLAWS OF OUR ORGANIZATION:

The Governing Board shall be responsible to appoint and approve at the appropriate time under these Bylaws a Nominating Committee composed of seven resident members in good standing for purposes of placing in nomination a ticket to be submitted at the General Membership Meeting for the election of Flag Officers and eight members of the Governing Board. Five members of the Nominating Committee shall constitute a quorum.

Not less than thirty days prior to the annual General Membership meeting, the Governing Board shall appoint a Nominating Committee to serve, said committee shall nominate a ticket to be submitted at the general membership meeting for the election of Flag Officers and two (2) year term members of the Board, and vacancies of the one (1) year remaining members of the Board. The ticket as selected by the Nominating Committee shall be posted in the Club house and a copy thereof mailed with the notice of the annual general membership meeting to all voting members of the club by the Secretary no less than twenty (20) days prior to the date of the annual membership meeting.

Nominations of Alternate Tickets. Any seven members in good standing may agree to place in nomination any other ticket, or tickets, if more than one is properly placed in nomination, shall be posted in the Club house not less than ten (10) days prior to the annual membership meeting, and shall be delivered to the Secretary in sufficient time for the Secretary to mail copies of said ticket or tickets to all voting members of the club not less than ten (10) days prior to the annual membership meeting.

No nominations shall be considered at the general membership meeting except as made in the manner provided herein.

To be elected at the annual membership meeting, each elected Flag Officer and member of the Governing Board must receive a majority of the ballots cast, where alternate tickets are submitted, voting shall be by secret ballot. Where alternate tickets are submitted, a voting member may cast one vote for one nominee for each Flag Officer position, and shall not be required to vote for all nominees as there are Board Member positions to be filled, and may vote for anyone duly nominated as a Board Member without being required to vote for all nominees of a same ticket. Those nominated for election to the four (4) two year term positions to the Governing Board receiving the highest total number of votes shall be elected; and in the same manner for those nominated to fill vacancies in the positions having one year unexpired terms remaining.

NOTE: This year we will be electing Flag Officers (Commodore, Vice-Commodore, Rear Commodore, Fleet Captain, & Fleet Surgeon) and Governing Board members (4) to one-year terms. OUR PRESENT GOVERNING BOARD MEMBERS ARE: TWO YEAR TERMS--JACK BOICE, BETTY D'AQUILLA, SAM MAXWELL, AND LENNY SAWYER ONE YEAR TERMS--GUY CATALANO, CHARLIE WOOD, DEANNA BUTLER, AND DICK MARX.
