

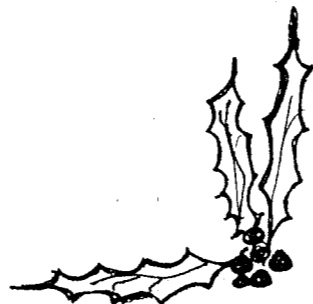
X-MAS PARTY
