FROM THE BRIDGE:

Dear Members: GOOD NEWS!!

The Federal Judge acted favorably on our petition requesting relief from the sand beach ordinance of 1970. This is definitely a milestone for our future growth. We have been in a state of limbo for the past year, not knowing where our building would be built. Now, there is no doubt as to the location - "north end of the Long Beach harbor". Look for our sign to be erected soon on the building site. Our special thanks to Mr. Robert E. Galloway, the attorney who handled our case and Mr. Charles E. Wood, attorney and past governing board member, who worked all last year on this project.

The Building Committee is working feverishly to complete the proposed plans. These should be finished in several weeks. There will be a general membership meeting called in the near future to adopt a building plan and finance program. You will be given ample notice to view the building plans prior to the meeting. They will be on display in the temporary club house for all to see.

Our current membership is approximately 235. This is slightly lower than we had anticipated. The normal loss through attrition should have been in the figure of about 50. We must join in an effort to help build up our member strength. Keeping in mind, the higher the membership - the lower the bond indebtedness per member to build our club house. I know from personal experience that many prospective members are waiting until we complete a building before they will join. Let me assure you this is unrealistic thinking. Those persons who join after we have purchased bonds and built the club will be required to pay an equal amount in initiation fees to cover what we paid in the bond. These monies will go to help retire the bonds you and I have purchased. Your

- April 23-24 Jordan River Classic B, WYC

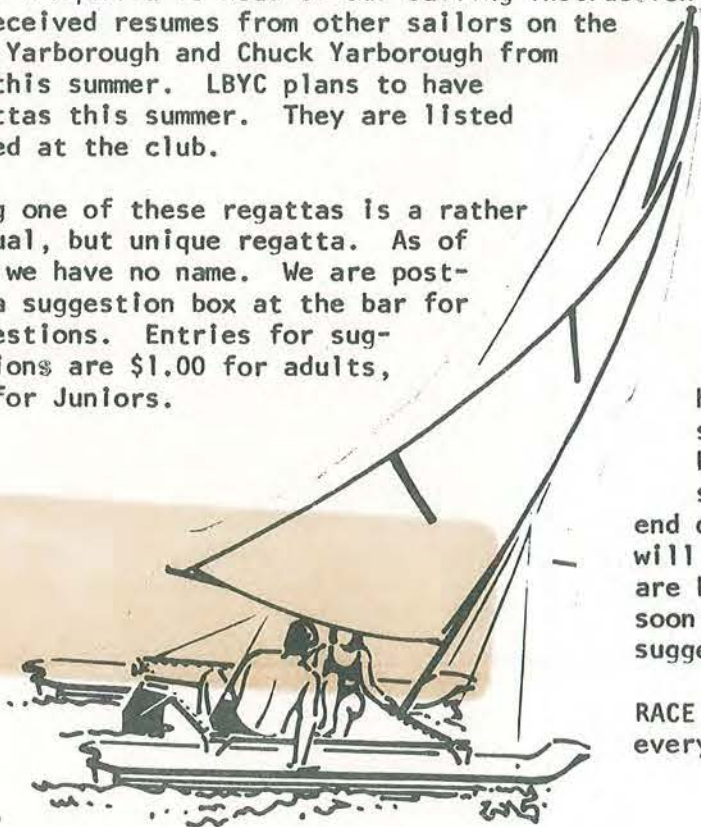
If you are interested in sailing in any of these regattas, please notify Laura Nelson at 864-2964.

The response to our Adult Sailing Classes was proof enough that we've got the sailing spirit. Although the classes are full, we will have another program in the near future.

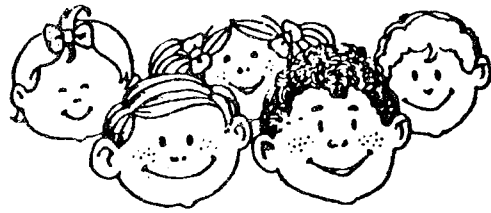

The Junior and Senior members had a great time at the kite flying contest last Sunday. Prizes of L.B.Y.C. T-shirts were awarded to the following:

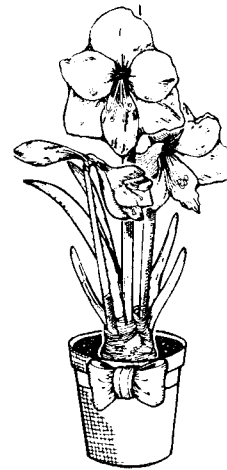
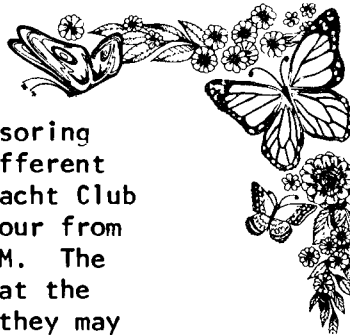
