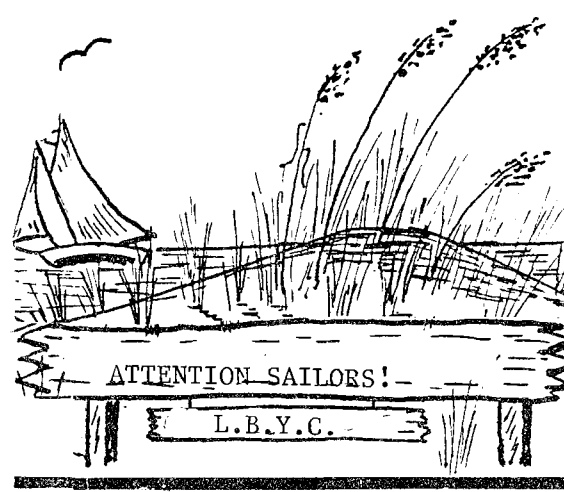

There will also be individual sailing lessons on Sunfish type sailboats for the younger children. Minimum age for the Sunfish class is up to the parent's discretion.
