



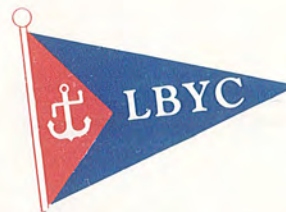

Social hour starts at 6:30 p.m. with free draft beer and "Hawaiian Stingers".

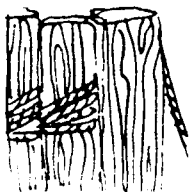
Food will be served at 7:00 and the menu will be:

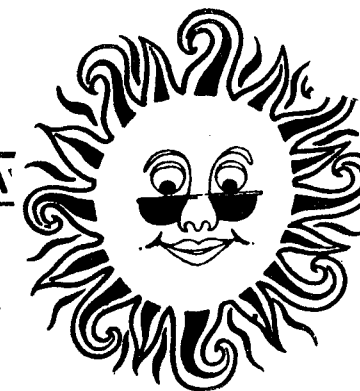
