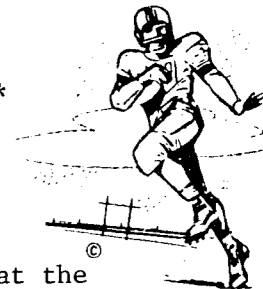
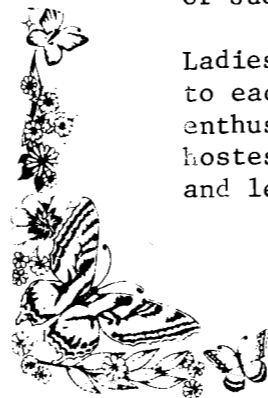
MONDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL RETURNS:

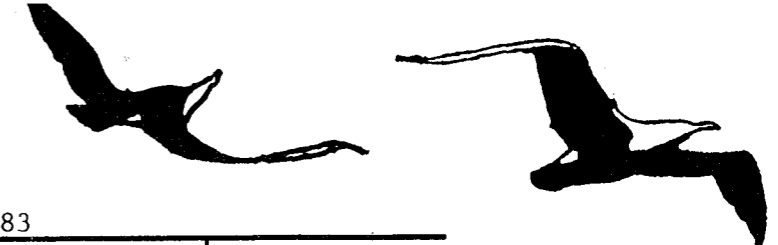
