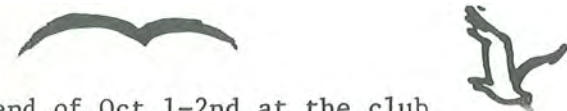


We have made our list and checked it twice. Guess what?

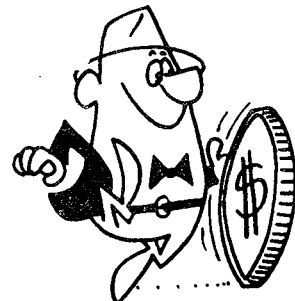

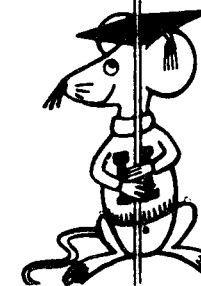


