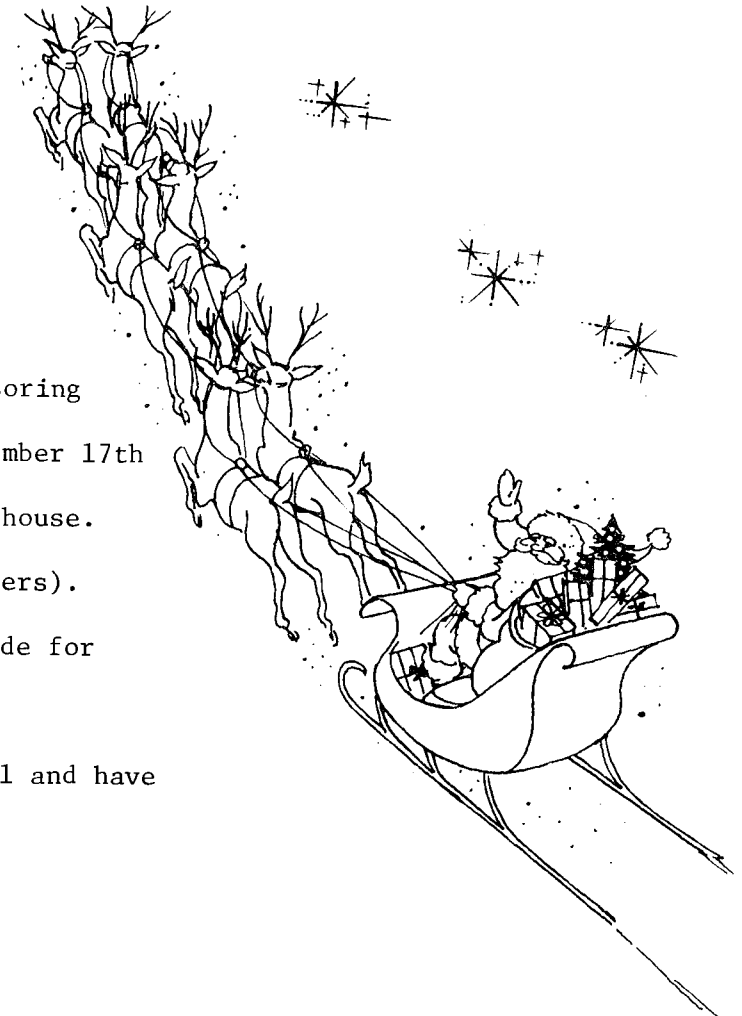

FROM THE RACE AND SAIL COMMITTEE:

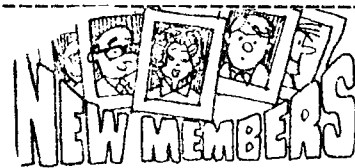
