Hey Kids! Come meet the Easter Bunny on Saturday, April 21. The party will be held at our temporary club on Magnolia, and the schedule is as follows:

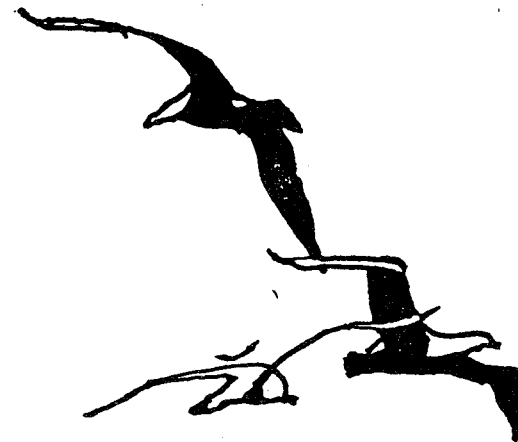

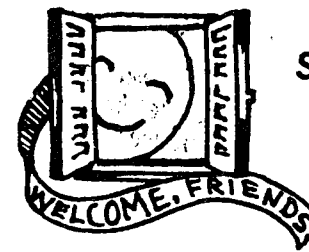

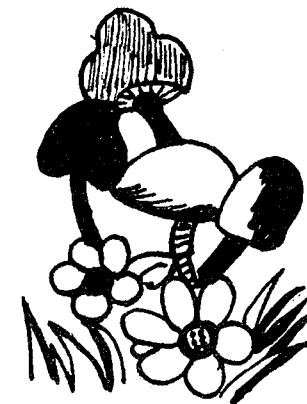
