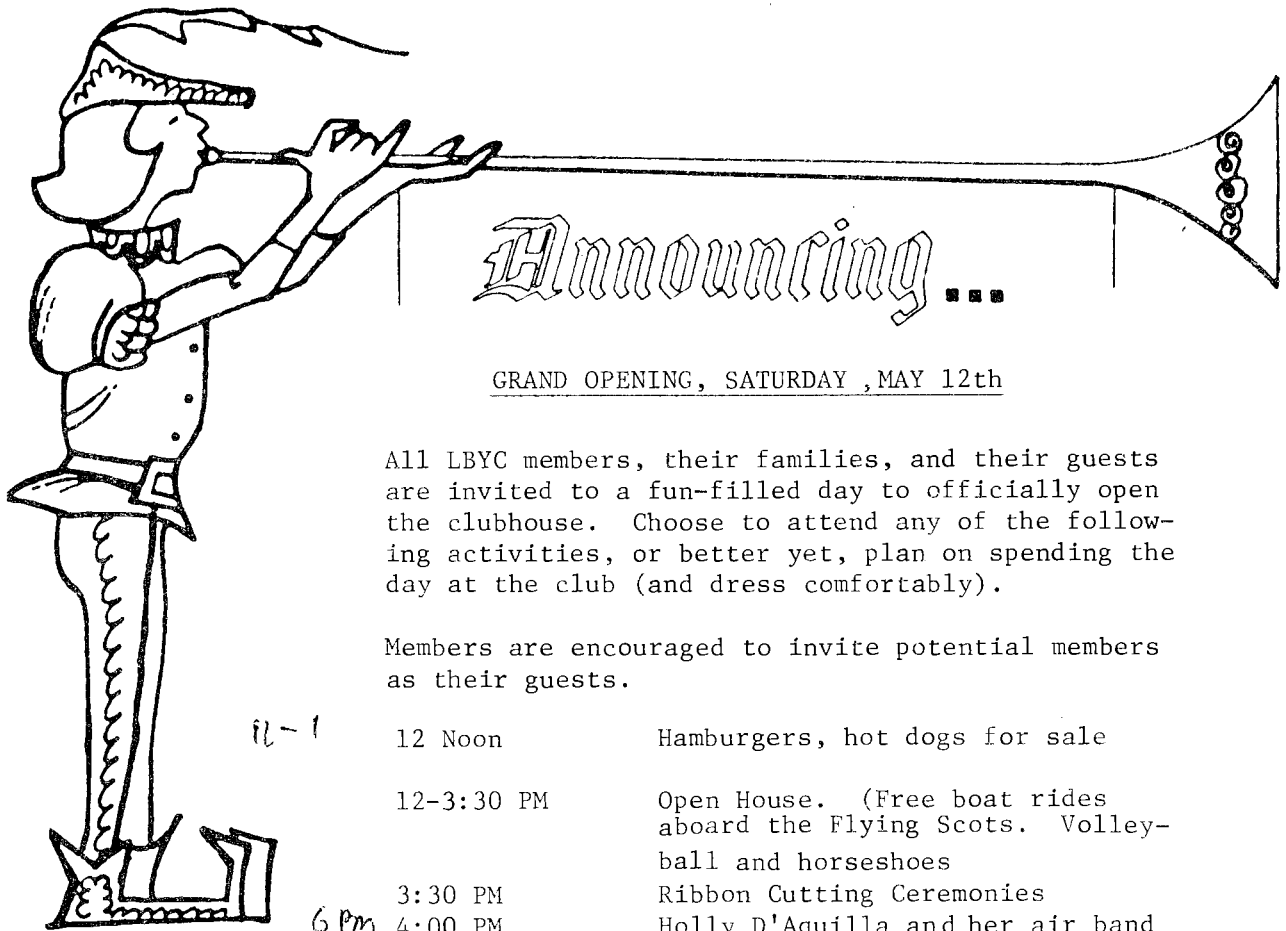

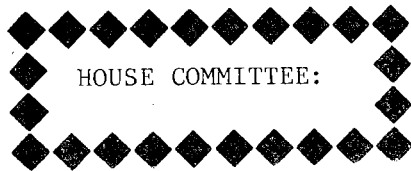

I hope some of you, the members, will be able to help the House Committee at different times during the year.

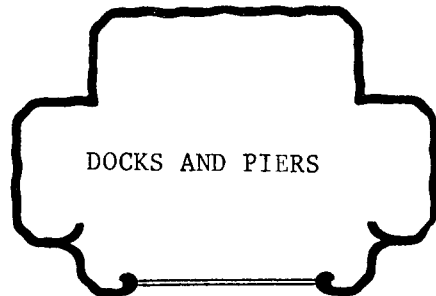
Everyone is welcome at the House Committee meetings, and they will be held on a week night. Watch your newsletter for dates and times.

I hope to see you all at the Grand Opening enjoying our new facilities, and scanning our new horizons.

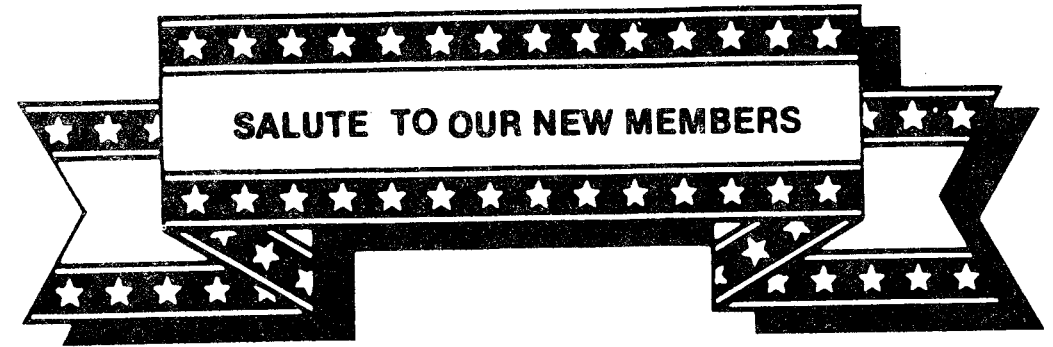
