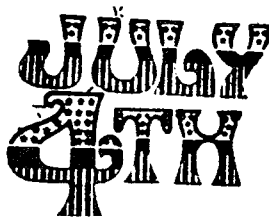

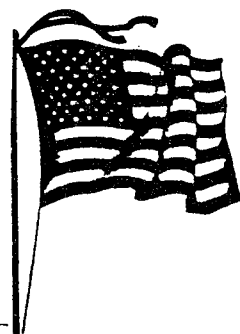

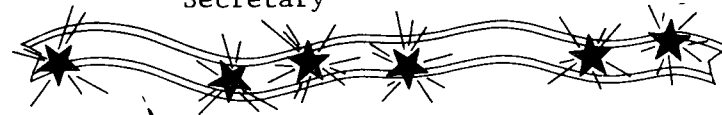
There was a big turn out for our June Ladies' Night at the Club. Thank you, Diane Evans and your committee for all of the good hor d'oeuvres that you furnished.

The chances can be purchased by Auxiliary and non-Auxiliary members and are 50¢ each or 3 for \$1.00.

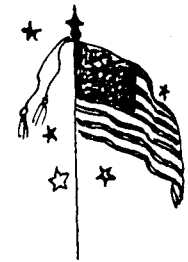

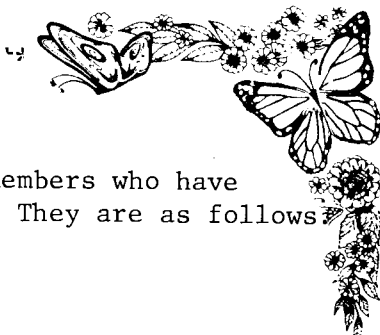

I believe it became great because of its faith in God, its hope for independence, and its love of freedom.

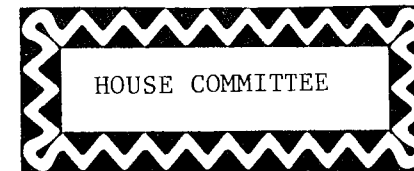
I am grateful for America's glorious past; I am awed by its unbelievable present; I am confident of its limitless future.

RACE AND SAIL COMMITTEE:

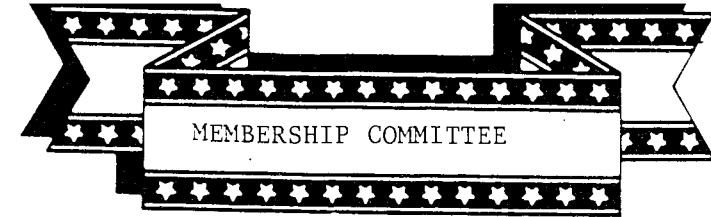
