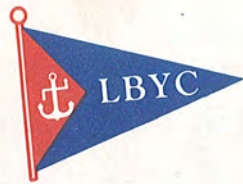

RACE CAMP:

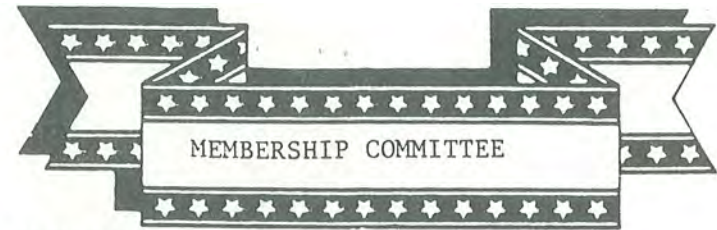
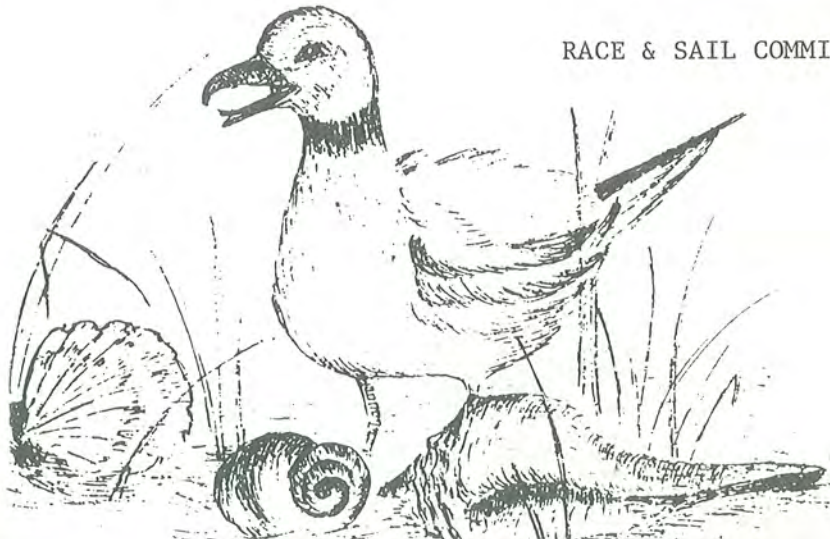
