Please note that when we visit another yacht club, we are guests of that club. We should not abuse this kindness by advertising for personal gain in any form.

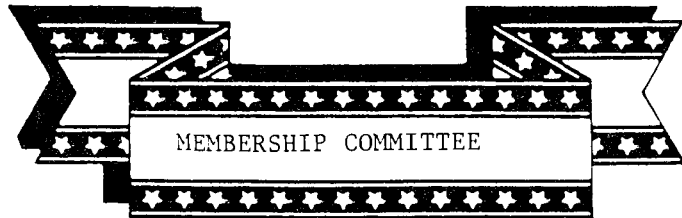
Our insurance committee chairman states that any vehicle used to tow a yacht club boat trailer must have liability coverage.
