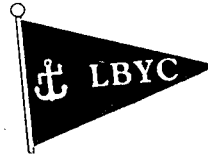
JUNIORS COMMITTEE:

LBYC was well represented at the Lipton Regatta at Pensacola Yacht Club both by racers and spectators. We took a 17th overall out of 24 clubs participating.

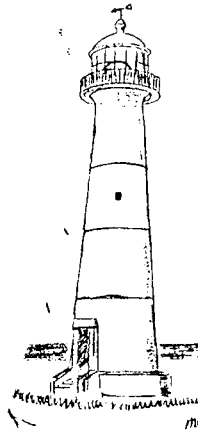
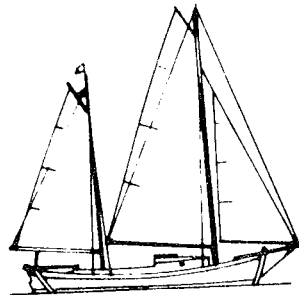
