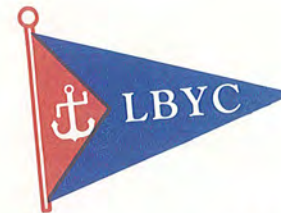

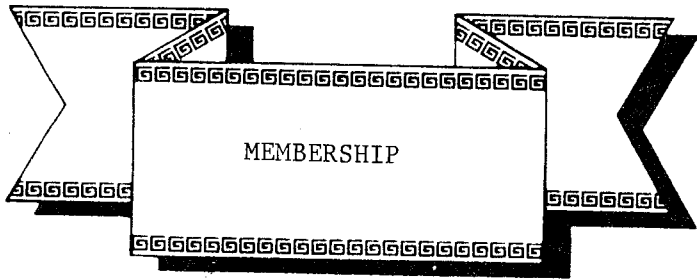
Not only was the lounge open, but Sallie Kapp had available coffee and cake. It was a very pleasant evening.

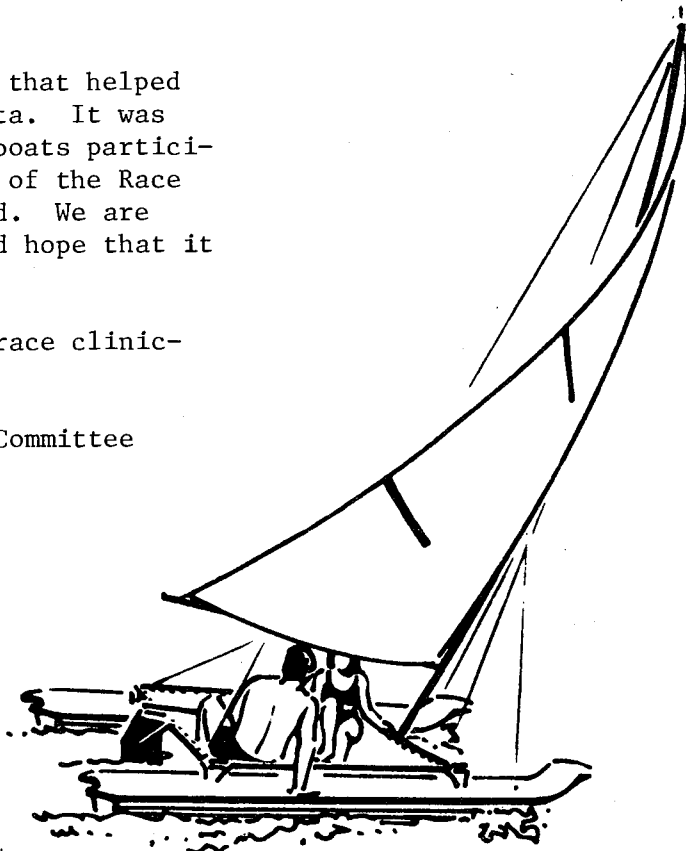

Don't forget the Race and Sail Committee meeting on November 14th.

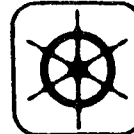

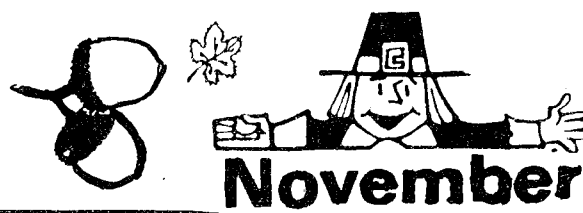
