FROM THE BRIDGE (Continued)

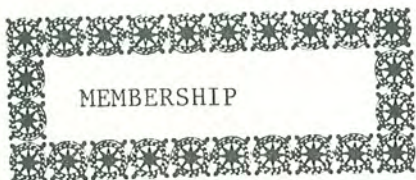
