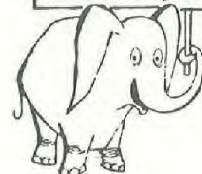

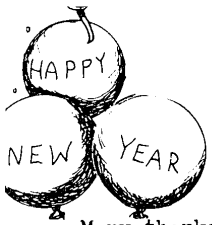
Membership
