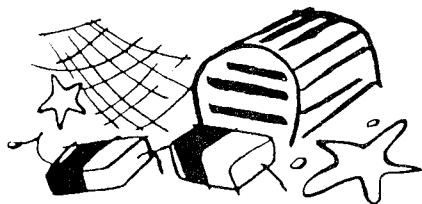

I would like to thank everyone who helped with the pig roast and anniversary party. We had fun and saw a lot of our members having a good time.

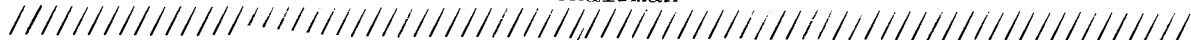

PENPOINT from the editor



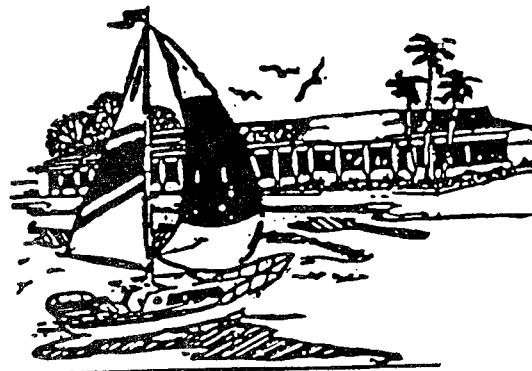
