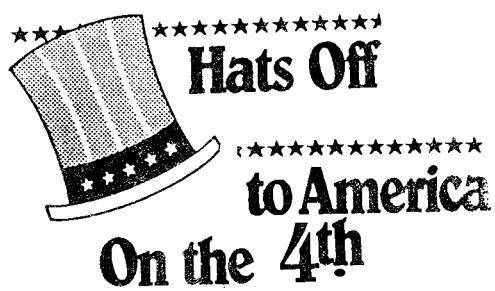

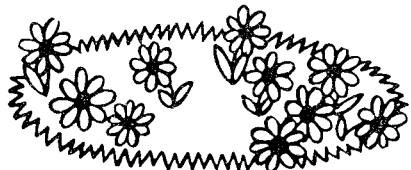

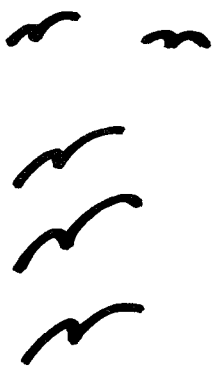

#### SAFE SAILING TIPS

- Look up before raising sailboat masts.
- Become familiar with the location of power lines in the area you launch your sailboat.
- Never leave masts up when transporting a sailboat.
- Don't pick up sailboats and carry them across parking lots with masts up; this adds to the risk of bumping into power lines.
- If you sail in an area where power lines cross the body of water, beware of changing tides and water levels. Don't take for granted that you can pass under a power line even if you have before.



Many Southeast Mississippi residents enjoy sailing as a leisure activity. But sailing can be deadly if metal masts come in contact with a live power line.

Overhead wires have become such an integral part of the scenery around the country that many sailors simply forget to look up when raising the masts of their sailboats.

When a metal mast touches a power line, the electric current flows through the mast and anything or anyone in contact with the boat on its way to the ground. Severe burns, loss of appendages, and possible cardiac arrest are often the tragic result. In the past five years, an estimated 10 to 15 sailors have died nationwide as a result of masts hitting power lines. Two similar accidents have occurred on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, resulting in one death and four injuries.

#### ENTERTAINMENT COMMITTEE

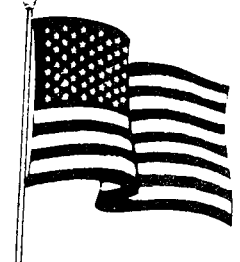
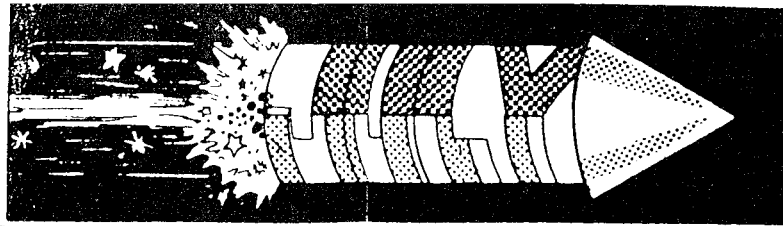
The summer dance was great fun for all who attended. Mike and Cathy Keel had us dancing till midnight.
