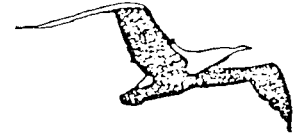
The week before the Junior Liptons, we will conduct a Juniors Race Camp at a cost of \$10.00 per person.

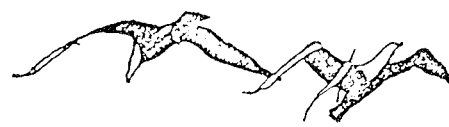
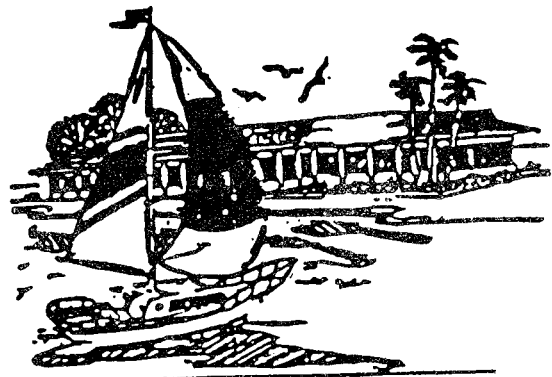
July was the final month for qualification for skipper in this regatta. There is still a need for crew, so come on down and let your interest be known.

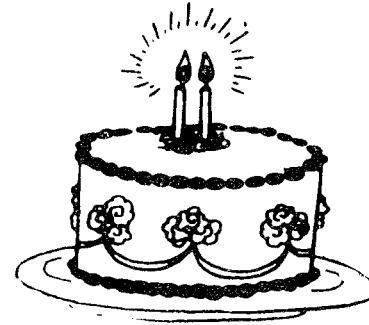
The Junior Liptons will be in New Orleans August 17-18. How about a big cheering section? Any power boaters as spectator boats???

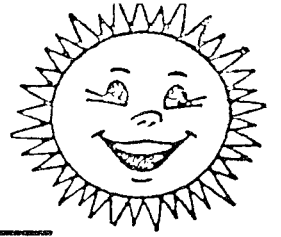
