Our ladies sailed a good race at the Knost. Congratulations to Holly, Ronda and Betty.

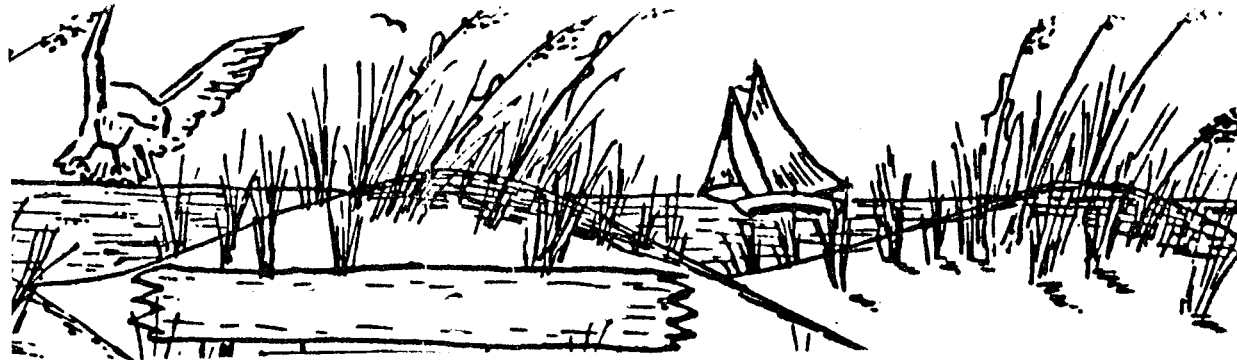

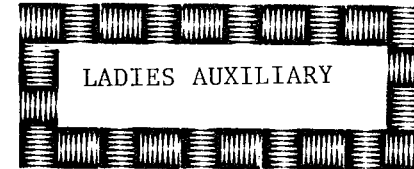
The Juniors had a great time at NOYC at the Junior Liptons. We placed a 12th overall with a 9th, 10th, and 14th.
