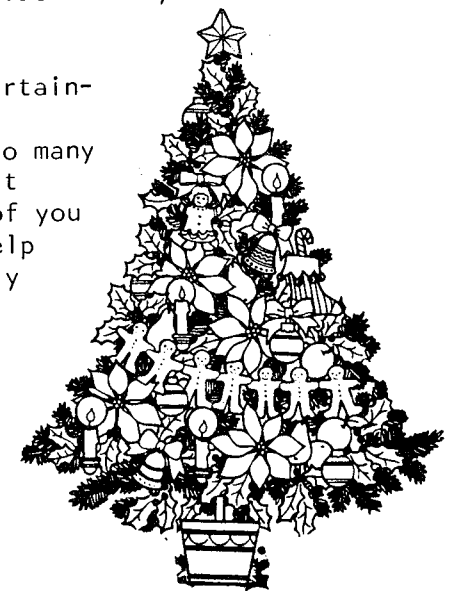
ENTERTAINMENT COMMITTEE:
