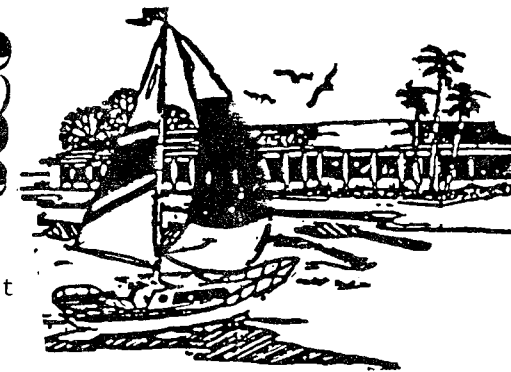

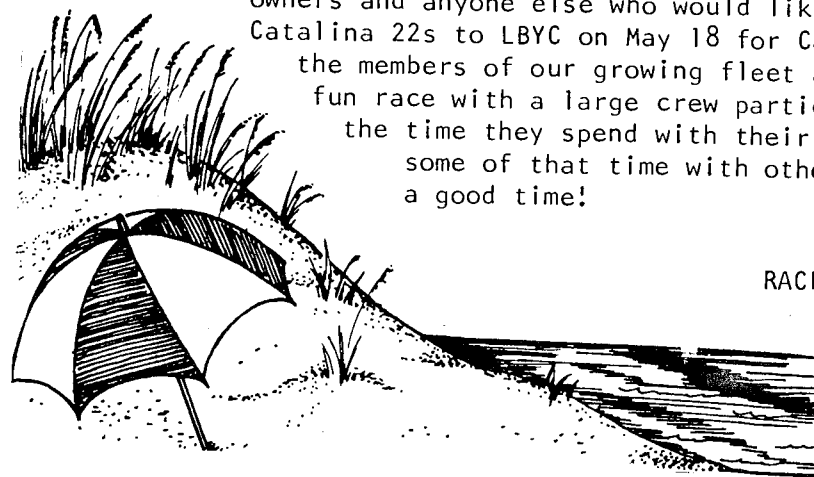
For the serious competitor North Sails will have its Smart Course on March 8-9. Contact Don Roberts or Bruce Page for details.

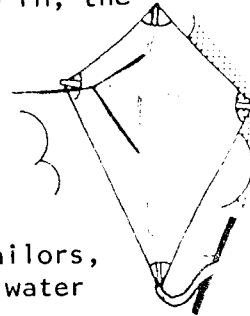
Have A Fun Day

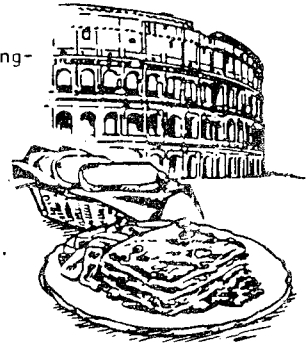



