All Junior meetings will be on the 2nd & 4th Wednesdays of this month at 7 PM.

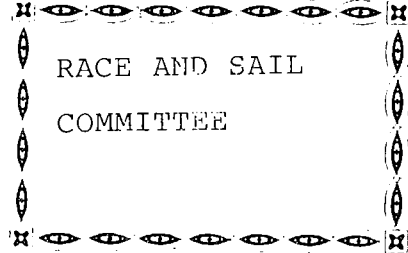
Officers for this year are: Gretchen Bell, Commodore, Andy Christ, Vice Commodore & Jeremy Christ, Rear Commodore.

It was sure a lot of fun. Hope to see more members participate next year.

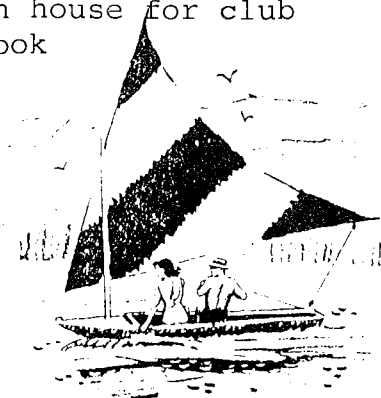
