MEMBERSHIP: Everyone please say "Hello" to our newest members - Bill and Kay Braswell. We welcome them into our club.

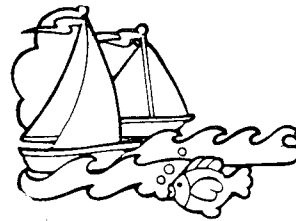
