



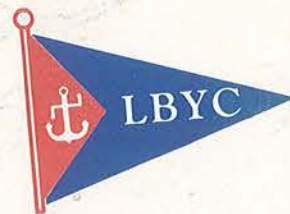

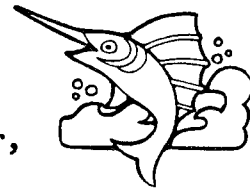
If you are one of those who have not been attending, and you have suggestions as to how these events could be made more attractive to you, please let someone on House Committee know.
