

BYLAWS COMMITTEE

I would like to take this opportunity to explain just some of the proposed changes that, with the blessings of the Governing Board, will be before you at the general membership meeting in October.

Under Article I, NAME AND LEGAL ENTITY, the proposal is to rearrange some words for easier understanding with no effect on its meaning.

Under Article IV, GOVERNING BOARD, there are several changes. First, the language regarding "Special Meetings" is changed making it easier to call such meetings. Old language allowed special meetings to be called only at regular or special meetings. New language allows special meetings to be called at any time.

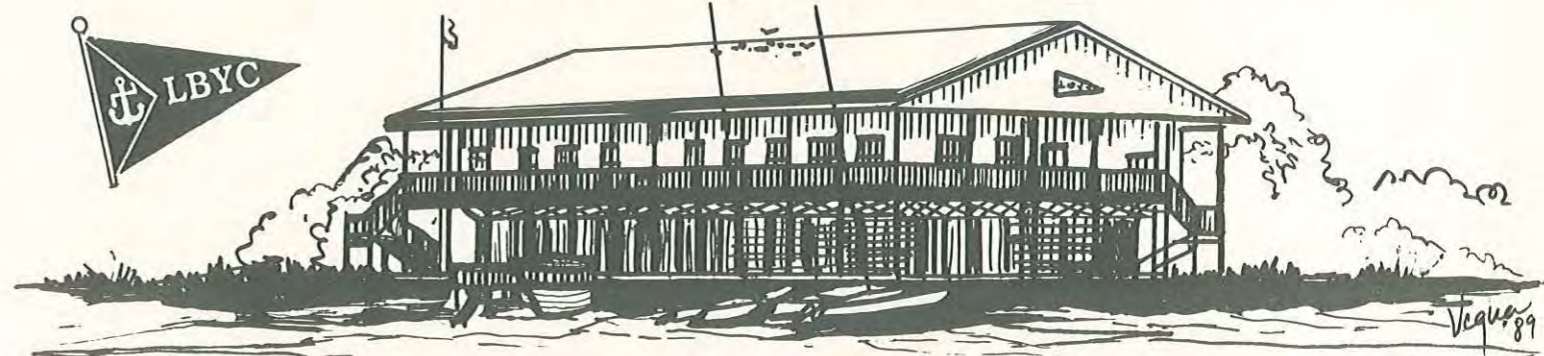
Second, a "quorum" will be defined as a majority rather than eight members.

Third, "Fixing Dues" will be changed to "Determining Dues" and "non-members" will be changed to "applicants".

There are other proposed changes which I will discuss in upcoming newsletters. Meanwhile, there is still a lot of time to alter what needs to be altered in order to end up with a fine document come October. Your ideas are welcome.

As you have heard the membership voted to allow the Board to borrow up to \$100,000 from our members through construction notes.

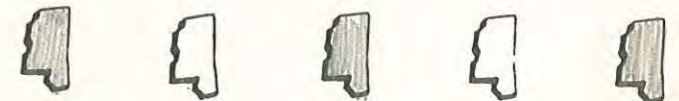
