BEACH MASTER

In an effort to keep track of who owns the many trailers and boats parked on club property, we have come up with a new numbering system. Example: "LBYC # 123" It would probably be best to buy the 3" plastic stick-on letters sold in hardware stores, but any

system that won't readily fade and is legible is OK.

Everyone is reminded to check with the BEACH MASTER before parking a boat or trailer on club property. The fee is \$20.00 per calendar year, or any portion of the year. Space is assigned on a first come, first served basis. Please have your trailer and any boat that is not on a trailer marked as described by the deadline of May 1st. so that we will know who owns the boats and trailers.

We would prefer that the letters and the numerals be placed on the tongue of the trailer, and on the stern of the boat.
