The person named below has applied for membership in the Long Beach Yacht Club. His application will be presented to the Governing Board for approval on December 13, 1995.

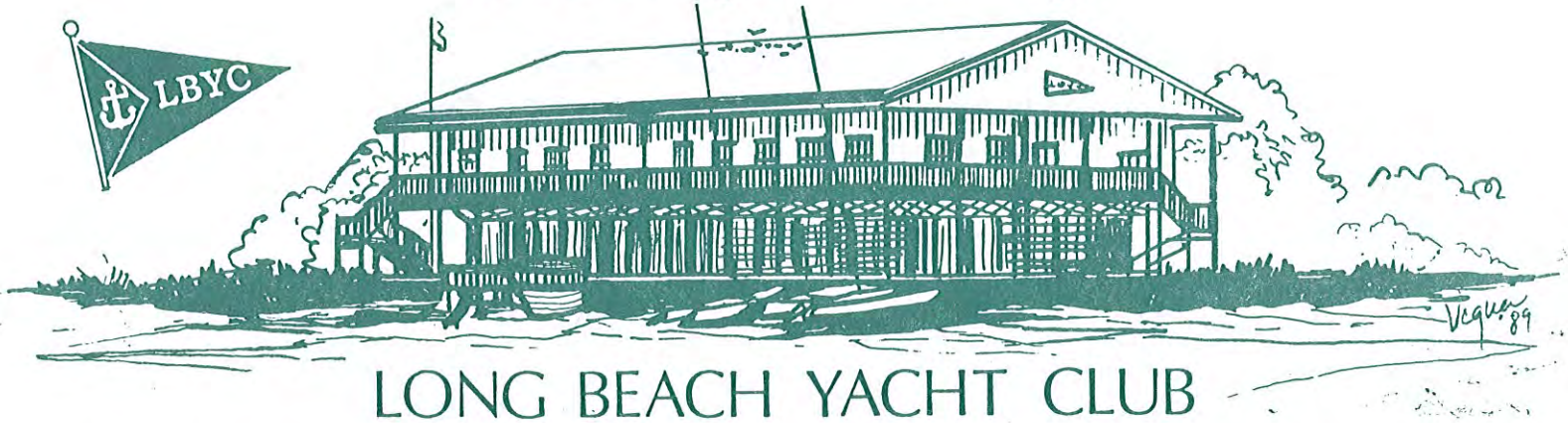
