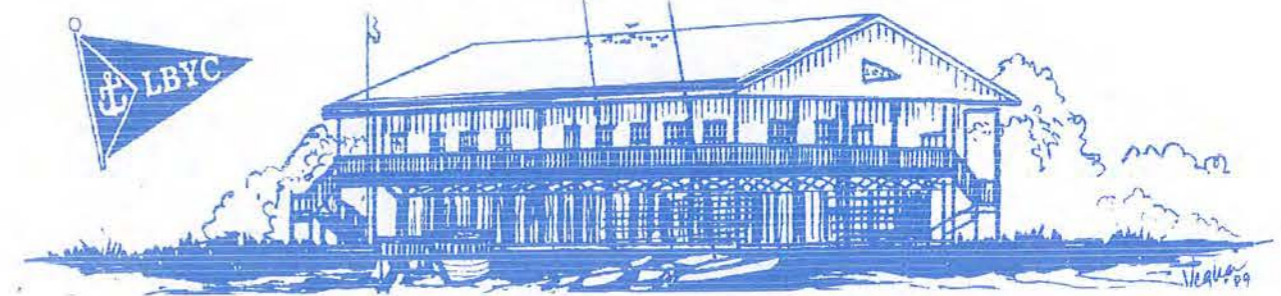
RACE & SAIL COMMITTEE
