

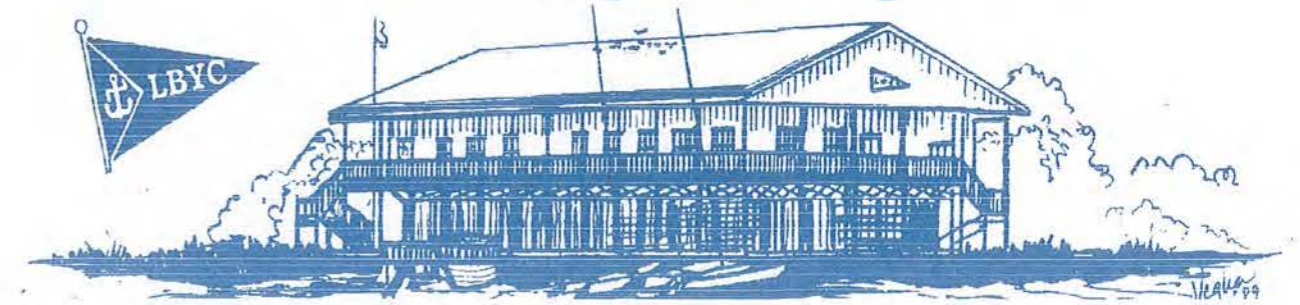
ENTERTAINMENT COMMITTEE
