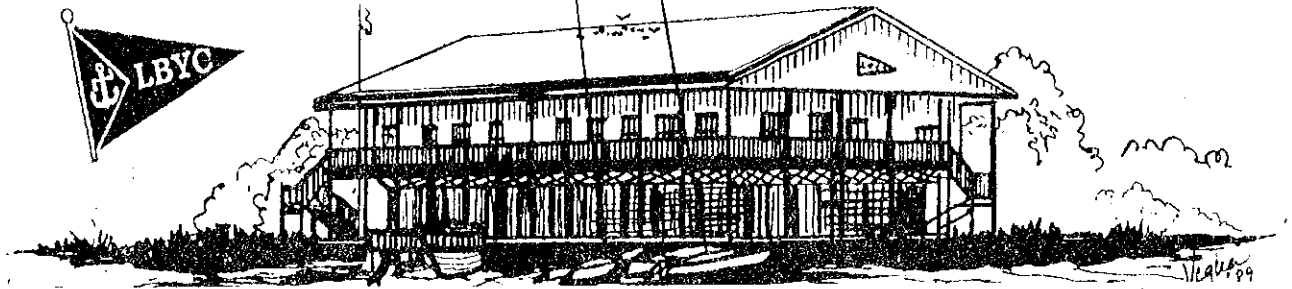

## MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 2005

Minutes of the Long Beach Yacht Club Board of Governors, December 14, 2005

Martin Jones called the meeting to order at 7 PM and briefed the general membership on the finances of the Club. See attached concerning insurance claims.

Election of Flag Officers and Board of Governors were unanimously voted in by the general membership.

New Business:

Bo Clarke made a motion that dues temporarily be decreased to \$100.00 in January. As more services are offered, dues could be increased. Motion was seconded and carried.

Commodore Hancock said if anyone had a problem with this, especially those who lost everything in Katrina, they should see him.

Bo Clarke made a motion to waive the dues for the Commodore. Motion was seconded and carried.

Bill Caraway made a motion to keep the temporary building at or below \$25,000 with a minimum finished floor level equivalent to the old deck floor level. Motion was seconded and carried.

Motion was made by my outgoing Commodore Jones that flag officers be able to sign three accounts consisting of house accounts, elevator, and operating account, and also the safety deposit box. Motion was seconded and carried.

Motion was made to purchase two each (6 month jumbo cd's in \$100,000 increments with no penalty for one early withdrawal if necessary on each one. Motion was seconded and carried.

Motion was made to authorize the Commodore to spend \$10,000 to bring the Club to operational status. Motion was seconded and carried.

Meeting adjourned at 8:50 PM. The next meeting will be the third Monday in January.
