## 2013 CLUB DUES

**HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL!!** It's that time of year. Club dues for 2013 are reflected on your December statement. In accordance with Long Beach Yacht Club (LBYC) Bylaws, dues/deposit must be paid by **February 15, 2013**. Yearly dues are as follows:

Resident Regular - \$600  
Military (Active Duty) - \$450  
Non-Resident - \$300  
Intermediate - \$300  
Junior - \$35

You have two options concerning payment of your dues. They are:

1. Pay dues in full by February 15, 2013
2. Elect the payment plan with a deposit by February 15, 2013

If you choose the payment plan, I would appreciate a **note** with your December payment. Payment plan schedule is shown below.

**Resident Regular Dues** - \$200 due 2/15/13; then \$50 a month for 8 months (total of \$600)  
**Military Dues (Active Duty)** - \$150 due 2/15/13; then \$37.50 a month for 8 months (total of \$450)  
**Non-Resident Dues** - \$100 due 2/15/13; then \$25 a month for 8 months (total of \$300)  
**Intermediate Dues** - \$100 due 2/15/13; then \$25 a month for 8 months (total of \$300)  
**Junior Dues** - \$35 due 2/15/13 (total of \$35) – one time payment

In order to be considered a LBYC member in good standing, all 2012 club charges must be paid in full by January 20, 2013, and you must pay either full 2013 dues or the payment plan amount by 2/15/13.

\*\*\* After payment is received, Non-resident members will be sent a new 2013 membership card. All other current members may pick up their cards **at the LBYC** (there will be no mail out).
